Palliative Care vs. Hospice Care ..... choosing the right level of care at the right time. Palliative Care is specialized care for patients with serious illness. Palliative Care is delivered while patients are seeking curative treatment and is focused on comfort, symptom management, and quality of life. Hospice Care is end-of-life care or when serious illness moves to end stage. Hospice Care is also focused on comfort, symptom management, and quality of life although patients stop curative treatment before electing hospice care.
